Families First provides various services for approximately 2500 children monthly in Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa and Walton counties. One of their many services focuses on foster families and adoption services. This organization was thrilled to hear about our desire to help, and said they are currently in a crisis with so many children needing foster homes.

They are in desperate need of baby/toddler consumables such as diapers (all sizes), pull-ups (all-sizes), wipes, formula (dry or power; all stages), bottles/bottle liners, etc. While many of us are not able to open our homes to foster children, the least we can do is support those families that are able to do this work by giving them the basic supplies needed for God's children.

We will start a house competition on March 19th, to see which house of knights and their supporting classrooms can collect the most of these supplies! The contest will last for one week, ending on Friday, March 27th.

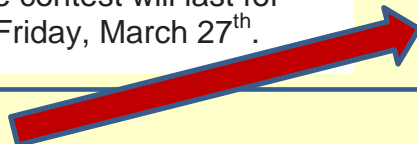

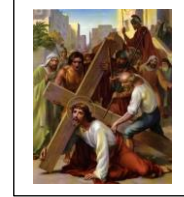

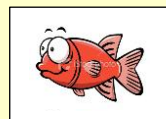
