Middle School Knightly News

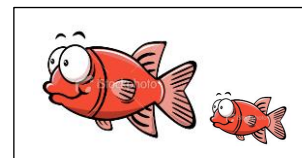

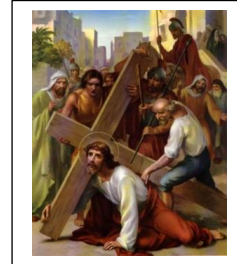
