Sunday: Parish Appreciation Day

- **Open House, 12:00-2:00**

Monday: Community Appreciation Day

- **Students may wear their favorite sports team attire.**
- Penny War begins – all monies collected will be given to charities. The procedure of a Penny War is as follows:
 - A container is placed outside of each homeroom in the morning.
 - Students from the class put their pennies in their class' container. One point is received for every penny in the container.
 - Students may put silver coins and paper currency into the containers of OTHER classes to “bomb” them. Each silver coin or bill reduces the number of points from that container by the amount of the coin or bill. (e.g. a nickel reduces the points by five, a dime by ten, a dollar by 100, etc...) This is where strategy counts and where the students have fun with it!
 - The classroom winner will be announced on Friday.
- **Students** bring in a sack lunch to be donated to the Waterfront Rescue Mission soup kitchen. Lunches should include: sandwich, fruit, snack, and beverage. Optional item: note (prayer, thinking of you, etc.)
